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## Class Expectations

- Have a positive attitude
- Be on time and prepared. If you are delayed by a staff member, please obtain a pass.

## Attendance

Practice work should be completed when assigned and checked on the Weebly page http://chapmannovi.weebly.com/. Try every problem then correct your mistakes by redoing the problem. Practice assignments are worth 5 points. Late assignments will be accepted up to one week late for a 1-point deduction.
Assignments will not earn credit if they are more than one week late.
Homework is to be completed in pencil.

## Assessments (Tests/Quizzes/Projects)

- Tests and quizzes must be completed in pencil. All assessments must be completed during the class period they are given; no extended time is given. Work must be shown on tests to get full credit!
- **Per the Mathematics Department policy, all graded tests are to remain in the classroom at all times. If a parent wishes to see a child's test, they need to schedule an appointment time with the counseling office to view the test. No notes about or pictures of the test are allowed to be taken. *
